Accreditation: All of the above universities are fully accredited by The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. Each university is separately accredited.

Explanation of Transcript

October 2003, the individual student information system databases of the six South Dakota public universities were merged into one database. Beginning Fall Semester 2003, all credit earned at any of the six universities will be listed under the term header. An identifier for the university teaching each course is placed on the transcript prior to the Course Subject as follows:

- B – Black Hills State University
- D – Dakota State University
- M – South Dakota School of Mines and Technology
- N – Northern State University
- S – South Dakota State University
- U – The University of South Dakota

This conversion to a single database necessitates that the student enrolled Before the Merge, or Before and After the Merge, will receive a transcript from each university attended at each level (credit has been transferred between the universities). Students who attend After the Merge Only will receive one combined transcript. Some students who attended prior to 1987 will receive a transcript that is a copy of their hard copy (non-electronic) transcript.

Summer 2019, the South Dakota public universities implemented a new student information system. Course and grading information are the same from the old system to the new but may display in a different format on the transcript. A running cumulative GPA after each semester is no longer included. Students enrolled pre and post the 2003 merge will still receive transcripts as outlined above from the universities attended. Contact the appropriate University with any questions.

Transcripts are issued only upon the written request of the student and payment of the required fees. In compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, no information contained on a transcript is to be released to a third party without the written consent of the student. Official transcripts issued will include all credit, at all levels, that has been earned at all six universities. Official transcripts are issued on security paper.

Academic Calendar

The universities are on a semester calendar: fall, spring, summer.

Academic Standing

A student is academically eligible to enroll unless indicated by an academic “Suspended” status.

Repeated Courses

For the Undergraduate and Graduate academic levels, only the last grade is used in computing the grade point average. For the Law School, only the first grade is used in computing the grade point average. For the Medical School, all grades are averaged in the grade point average. Repeated courses are marked with an “R” or “Repeated.”

Transcripts printed prior to summer 2019 include repeated courses in the semester GPA. Transcripts printed summer 2019 and later exclude repeated courses from the semester GPA.

Remedial Course Grades (RE)

Effective Fall 2003, RI, RS, and RU are used for grading remedial courses. Beginning summer 2019, remedial grades prior to Fall 2003 were converted to reflect an RE in front of the existing grade due to implementation of a new student information system. Some RE grades compute in the GPA and others do not. Contact the appropriate University with any questions.

Transferred Credit

All courses from regionally accredited post secondary undergraduate institutions are recorded as transferred and are expressed in semester hours. Other transfer credit is recorded as transferred only if it is equivalent to a specific course at one of the public universities. Official transcripts from other institutions are not reissued or copied for distribution.

Interstate Passport

ZPSS 001 Interstate Passport indicates the student has completed requirements for the WICHE Interstate Passport. Beginning Fall 2019, completion of the Interstate Passport is noted as a comment at the term level.
